Verb (3): Present Continuous

- The *present continuous tense* (also called the *present progressive tense*) is commonly used in English for actions happening right now, or in the future.
- This tense is formed using two components: the verb **BE** (in the present tense), and the **-ING** form of a verb.

Forming the Present Continuous

Subject	BE	-ING form
I	am	singing
You	are	singing
He	is	singing
She	is	singing
It	is	singing
We	are	singing
They	are	singing

Other examples such as reading, talking, studying, etc.

Forming the Present Continuous

- With many verbs, you can simply add -ING to the end of the verb. However, with some verbs, you need to change the ending a little.

Verb ending in...	How to make the -ING form	Examples
one vowel + one consonant	Double the consonant, then add -ING	swim – swimming hit – hitting get – getting
one vowel + one consonant + E	Remove E, then add -ING	come – coming lose – losing live – living

Idioms:

Idiom	Meaning
Cost an <u>arm</u> & a leg	If something costs an arm and a leg , it is very expensive! "The new house cost us an arm and a leg, but we have no regrets."
<u>Face</u> the music	If you have to face the music , you have to accept the unpleasant consequences of your actions. "He was caught stealing. Now he has to face the music!"
Keep a straight <u>face</u>	If you keep a straight face , you look serious although you really want to laugh. "I tried to keep a straight face while pulling a prank, but I failed."
