Noun

- A noun is a naming word. It names a person, place, thing, idea, living creature, quality, or action.
Examples: *cowboy, theatre, box, thought, tree, kindness, arrival.*

How to form the plural

Noun ending	Forming the plural	Example
most others	Add -s	cat cats face faces day days
s, x, ch or sh	Add -es	boss bosses tax taxes bush bushes
Ends with -f/-fe	Change to ves	knife knives life lives wife wives half halves wolf wolves loaf loaves

Irregular plural

Ends with -o	Add -es	potato potatoes tomato tomatoes
ALL KINDS	Change the vowel or Change the word or Add a different ending	man men foot feet child children person people tooth teeth mouse mice

Idioms:

Idiom

Meaning

Speak the same language

If two or more people **speak the same language**, they have similar tastes and ideas. "We work well together because we speak the same language."

Set the stage (for something)

If you **set the stage** for an event or a development, you create conditions that allow it to happen. "The agreement set the stage for their future working relationship."

Meaning

Play the game

If you **play the game**, you accept to do things according to generally- accepted customs or code of behavior. "Not all website owners play the game. Some download content from others without permission."

Build bridges

If a person **builds bridges** between opposing groups, they help them to cooperate and understand each other better. "The mayor spent years trying to build bridges between the different communities."
