#### **Asking for Directions:**

- Excuse me, do you know where the ... is?
- Excuse me, could you tell me how to get to ...?
- Is this the right way for ...?
- Are we on the right road for ...?
- I'm looking for ... this address.
- Do you have a map?
- Can you show me on the map?
- How far is it?
- Is it far?
- How far is it to ... from here?
- Is it a long way?

#### **Taking Directions:**

- It's this way / it's that way.
- You're going the wrong way / direction.
- Take this road.

Go down there.

- Take the first on the left. Take the second on the right.
- Turn right at the crossroads.
- It'll be ... on your left / on your right / straight ahead of you.
- It's not far / quite close / a long way to walk.

## Adjectives

- An adjective is a word that describes a person or thing: *big, pretty, expensive, green, round, French, loud, quick, fat, etc.*
- Example sentences: He has big blue eyes. The new car broke down. The old lady was talking in a quiet voice.
- Sometimes nouns function as adjectives. In other words, they come before another noun and describe it: *sports car, orange juice, television station, coffee shop, book cover.*

## **Types of Adjectives**

- Adjectives can be divided into several types:
  - Opinion: nice, pretty, original, expensive, etc.
  - Size: big, small, large, enormous, little, etc.
  - Age: young, old, new, ancient, etc.
  - Shape: round, square, flat, etc.
  - Color: blue, red, white, black, dark, bright, etc.
  - Origin: Italian, British, Mexican, western, southern, etc.
  - Material: metal, wooden, plastic, golden, etc.

## Determiners

- A **determiner** is a word that comes before a noun to show which person or thing you are talking about.
- A, an, the, my, your, some, any, several, enough, any.
- I have a red hat.
  Please give me my bag.
  Some people decided to leave.
  She doesn't want any money.
- Some people consider determiners to be a type of adjective. But you usually can use only one determiner at a time.

## **Idioms:**

Idiom	Meaning
Go in the right direction	<ol> <li>Lit. to head or travel in the right direction.</li> <li>Are you sure we are going in the right direction?</li> <li>We were supposed to turn back there. We are not going in the right direction.</li> <li>Fig. [for plans or intentions] to be progressing sensibly.</li> <li>Well, everything seems to be going in the right direction—for now anyway.</li> <li>Do you feel that this project is going in the right direction?</li> </ol>
A step in the right direction	An action that is expected to bring good results. Both sides agreed that continuing the talks was a step in the right direction.
